The majority of this study is on understanding worship by studying the various elements of the tabernacle and the old and new testament meanings.

This is a small soft cover book that is a stand alone book, with the NASB scripture printed in the book. There are 6 lessons total.

The 40 minute study series is an inductive study 'guide' designed to be completed in 40 minutes with no homework ahead of time (except for the leader) to help you discover for yourself what God says and how it applies to your life today. With the leader's notes and the Bible passages included right in the book, each self contained study is a powerful resource for personal growth and small group discussion.

Personally I took the time to do this study ahead of time so I felt I could get more out of the study and be able to have a better discussion on the material. But it is set up to do it together as a group each week without having 'homework' for the participants. This is on the way 'easy' side of all the Precepts studies, but not necessarily 'light' or 'easy' topics. You are directed to the scriptures as the main study and still use colored pencils or some way to make the 'markings' as in other inductive style studies. All the scripture is in the book, so if someone doesn't have a Bible, it is no problem. I have also done the 40 minute study called *How Do You Walk The Walk You Talk*, on Ephesians, and really loved that one (more than this one on Worship). It was deep but very good.
